# Head Teachers Update

- School Roll 85
- Staffing Mrs Jamieson has moved temporarily to St. John's, Blackwood.
- Primary 7 Hoodies ordered school will cover this cost.
- Tartan option cost £24.99 pinafore / £22 skirt. Consultation with wider Parent Forum now needed.
- SLC Unpaid work to carry out development of Reading Area. Shed has been ordered using Grant funds and those donated by Parent Council.
- School absence figures 5 pupils between 80-84% 6% Overall 34 pupils between 85 95% 40% Overall
- South Lanarkshire has committed to all pupils receiving workshop by June 2024. NSPCC created. Two assemblies P1-3 and P4-7. *Speak out. Stay safe.* is a programme for children aged 5-11 which aims to help children understand abuse in all its forms and to recognise the signs of abuse.

# Councillor Update

- McDonald's planning application was submitted by McDonald's and it was refused by South Lanarkshire Council. Application was then withdrawn by McDonalds. It was suggested McDonalds will reapply for planning permission.
- Everest Inn is opening soon and a discount will be offered for a short period of time.

- M74 Junction the work on the junction has started. Cameras will be installed at the traffic lights to discourage drivers from dropping their litter.
- Budgets £96million to be saved. Primary schools will not be affected. High schools transport boundaries will be affected if it is passed. Consultation has been sent out. A public meeting will be held in Holy Cross High School on Tuesday 30th January. Places must be booked.
- South Lanarkshire Council are not implementing the car parked on pavement policy.
- Councillors will buy the ties for the P.7 leavers.
