Changes to the Education board – Carole McKenzie is the new Executive Director of Education Resources from June 23. Carol was a former Primary Head Teacher and became a member of the Education Resources management team as Head of Education in October 2015.

Consultation will start with other schools in Larkhall on catchment areas.

New housing strategy 24-29. 2000 additional new homes will be built in South Lanarkshire, Larkhall is included. There are 4 sites for Larkhall included as a **Proposal**. 1. McWhirters old folk's home. 15 units for people with special needs / Elderly. 2. Old courtyard, 15 units. 3. Grier place, 40 units. 4. Meadow hill, 20 units. The developers will be South Lanarkshire council / West of Scotland housing & link housing. In total for Larkhall 90 units.

Proposed Upgrade M74 Slip Road – Work starting Jan 24. 2.1 million for upgrade & lights.

2 new Restaurants in Larkahall – Shanghai Oriental, now open. Where the old RBS was.

Everest Inn Opening November. Where the old Machan Volts was

Leisure Centre. Awaiting update on the recent closer of the Halls within leisure centre.

Councillor Carmichael attended a presentation on Community pay back team. The work that they do is amazing. Andy has arranged for someone to contact Mrs McLaughlin. They will come to the school and look out a project Mrs McLaughlin has in mind they will help design / supply manpower etc. School needs to supply the materials.
